Message from the Vice Chancellor



It is my pleasure to present the Annual Report of Bhattadev University, Bajali, for the academic year 2025–26. This year also marks six years since the institution was upgraded from Bajali College to Bhattadev University. Bajali College had earned widespread recognition as one of the most prominent educational institutions in the state, with a distinguished legacy spanning more than six decades. Named after Baikunthanath Bhagavat Bhattacharya, popularly known as Bhattadev, the University continues its journey towards becoming a centre of excellence in higher education, not only in Assam but across the nation. Bhattadev University is now a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and has expanded its collaborations with various academic and research institutions to promote the exchange of ideas, knowledge, and research.

Bhattadev University currently offers a wide range of academic programmes through its 19 departments. Of these, 17 departments offer Ph.D. programmes, 15 offer postgraduate courses, and all departments provide Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The University also offers three integrated programmes.

The University has a total student population of 3,444, comprising Ph.D., postgraduate, and undergraduate students. Of these, 63% are female and 37% are male. The demographic composition of the student community includes 60.4% from the Unreserved category, 24% from OBC/MOBC categories, 9.03% from Scheduled Castes (SC), 6.5% from ST(P), and 0.14% from ST(H).

The new campus of Bhattadev University at Medhikuchi, located approximately 5 km from the present campus, was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, on 30th December 2025. The campus is now ready for occupation, and prior to the commencement of the new academic session, the science departments will be shifted to the Medhikuchi campus. This transition will facilitate the establishment and strengthening of science laboratories and the expansion of postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes in the sciences. Necessary arrangements for the relocation are currently underway. The undergraduate programmes of all departments, along with the postgraduate and Ph.D. programmes under the Faculties of Social Sciences, Languages, Commerce, and Management, will continue to function from the Pathsala campus.

In its pursuit of academic excellence and knowledge creation, the University has established a Centre for Indian Knowledge Systems to promote research in traditional and indigenous knowledge, culture, and ancient studies. The University has also set up a Centre for Skill Development at the Pathsala campus. The Centre has commenced offering courses in computer proficiency, communicative English and Assamese, soft skills, and other skill-based programmes aimed at enhancing the employability and professional competencies of students..

Despite being a relatively young institution, Bhattadev University has made significant progress in the areas of research and development. The University has successfully secured sponsored research projects from prestigious national funding agencies, including DST, INSA, DBT, ICSSR, and ASTEC. Faculty members and research scholars have actively contributed to the University's growing research culture through quality research and publications. A considerable number of research articles have been published in reputed national and international journals ranked in the Q1, Q2, Q3, and Q4 categories across various indexing databases, reflecting the institution's steadily advancing academic and research excellence.

As Bhattadev University continues its journey of growth and transformation, we remain committed to strengthening academic excellence, enhancing research capabilities, and creating a vibrant learning environment for our students. The University will continue to focus on developing state-of-the-art infrastructure, promoting interdisciplinary research, and expanding collaborations with national and international institutions. At the same time, we are dedicated to fostering a student-centric and socially responsive academic community.

I place on record my sincere appreciation to our faculty members, officers, staff, students, alumni, affiliated colleges, and all stakeholders whose dedication, hard work, and unwavering support have contributed significantly to the University's progress. The achievements highlighted in this report are the result of our collective efforts and shared commitment to excellence.

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A Profile of Bhattadev University, Bajali

Bhattadev University, Bajali stands as the fulfillment of a long-cherished dream of the people of the greater Bajali region in Assam. It officially came into existence on June 24, 2019, with Prof. Birinchi Kumar Das assuming office as the first Vice-Chancellor. The university evolved from the esteemed Bajali College, an institution with a rich legacy of over six decades, widely recognized as one of Assam's leading centers of higher education.

Established under the Bhattadev University Act, 2017 - passed by the Assam State Legislature and assented to by the Governor on October 16, 2017 - the university bears the name of Baikunthanath Bhagavat Bhattacharya, famously known as Bhattadev. Revered as the father of Assamese prose, Bhattadev was a distinguished scholar of Sanskrit grammar and literature, whose profound knowledge of the Shrimadbhagavata Purana earned him the title Bhagavat Bhattacharya.

The foundation of Bajali College was the result of the vision, perseverance, and contributions of several prominent individuals of the Bajali area, alongside the immense sacrifice of the local agrarian community, who funded the college through the proceeds of their rice paddy sales. Under the dynamic leadership of Late Kameswar Das, a Gold Medalist from Calcutta University, Bajali College grew rapidly from its humble beginnings in 1955, achieving a reputation for academic excellence, especially in the sciences.

It is noteworthy that Bajali College introduced postgraduate programs in Geography and Zoology as early as the 1980s. The postgraduate program in Geography holds particular significance, being the second oldest in Assam after Gauhati University.

Bajali College endeavoured in its pursuit of academic excellence and, as expected, it was accredited with "A" Grade in its 2nd cycle of NAAC Assessment in the year 2016.

Despite being in its early stages, Bhattadev University introduced a postgraduate programme in Physics in its very first year. Building on this momentum, the University launched a five-year Integrated M.Sc. programme in Chemistry, Integrated M.A in Sanskrit and Integrated MCom starting from the 2022–2023 academic session. Currently, Bhattadev University offers postgraduate programmes in Mathematics, Assamese, Zoology, Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, English, Statistics, Philosophy and Political Science.

In a significant academic milestone, the University also initiated Ph.D. research programmes in several disciplines beginning in 2021. Further expanding its footprint, the Government of Assam has allotted a larger plot of land at Medhikuchi, near the existing campus, to establish a second campus. First phase of construction at this new site is already completed, supported by substantial government funding.

Simultaneously, efforts are being made to upgrade and refurbish the infrastructure at the existing Pathsala campus, aligning with the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 from the 2023–2024 academic year. To strengthen its academic foundation, the University recently appointed 17 talented individuals as Assistant Professors across various departments. Additionally, preparations are underway to recruit the vacant positions of Professors, Associate Professors, and Assistant Professors in sanctioned posts under the dynamic leadership of the current Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dhanapati Deka. Recruitment of non-teaching staff members against sanctioned posts is also actively in progress.

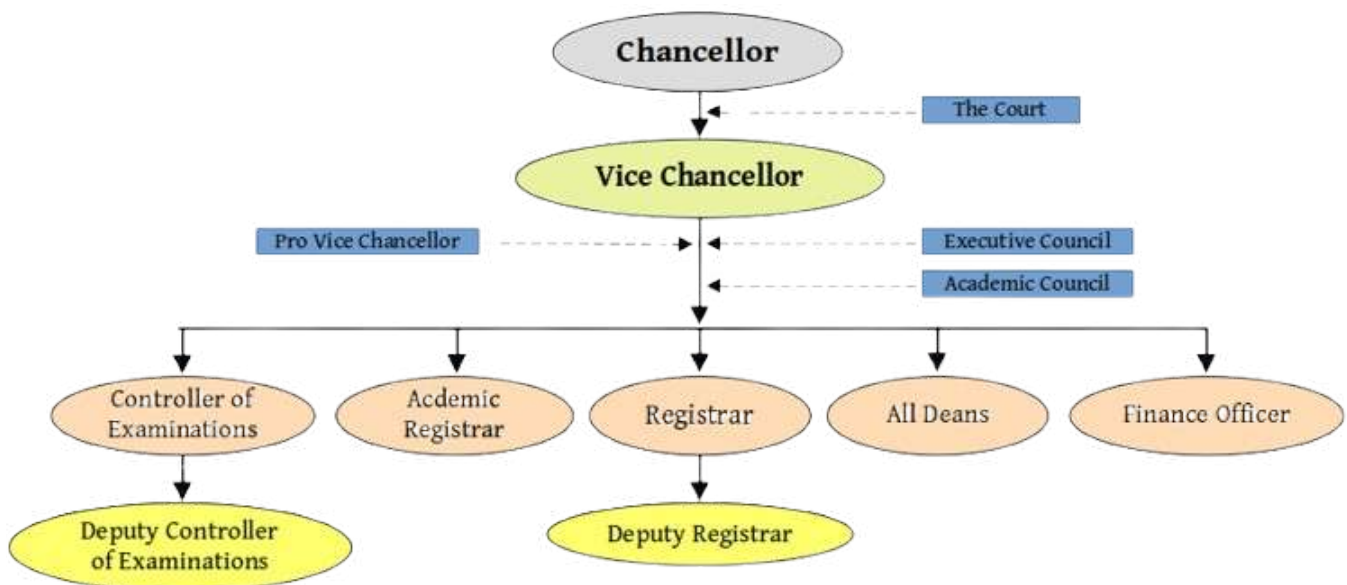
Vision :

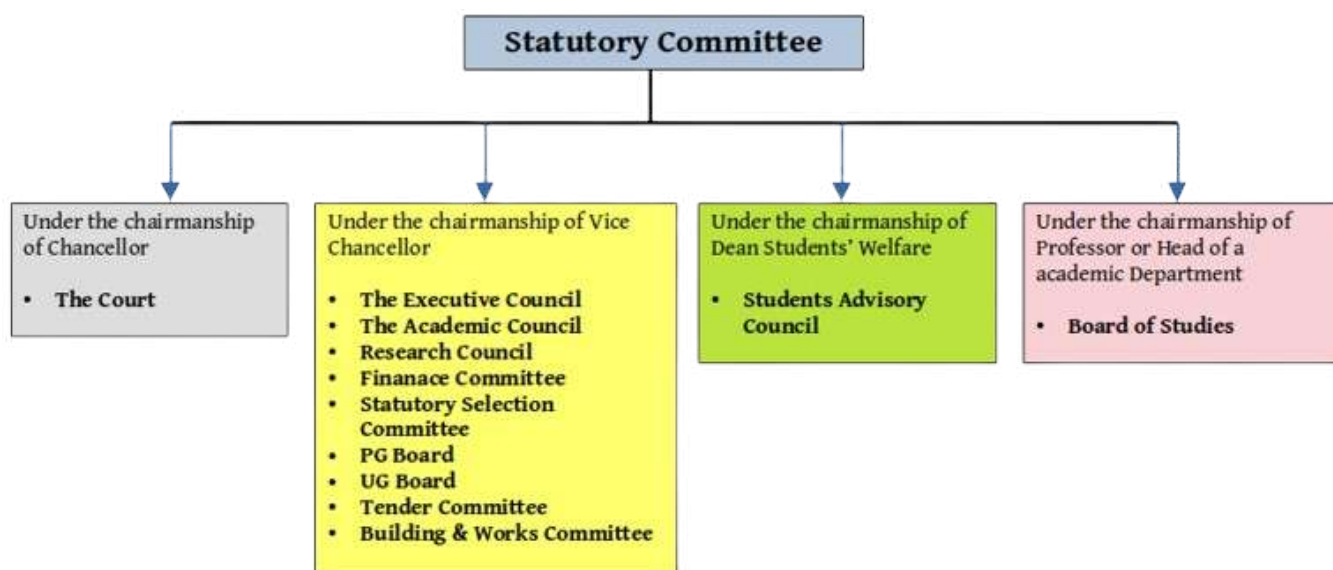
Mission :

- To pursue excellence in all spheres of involvement in order to become custodians of our culture and channels of communication with the world.

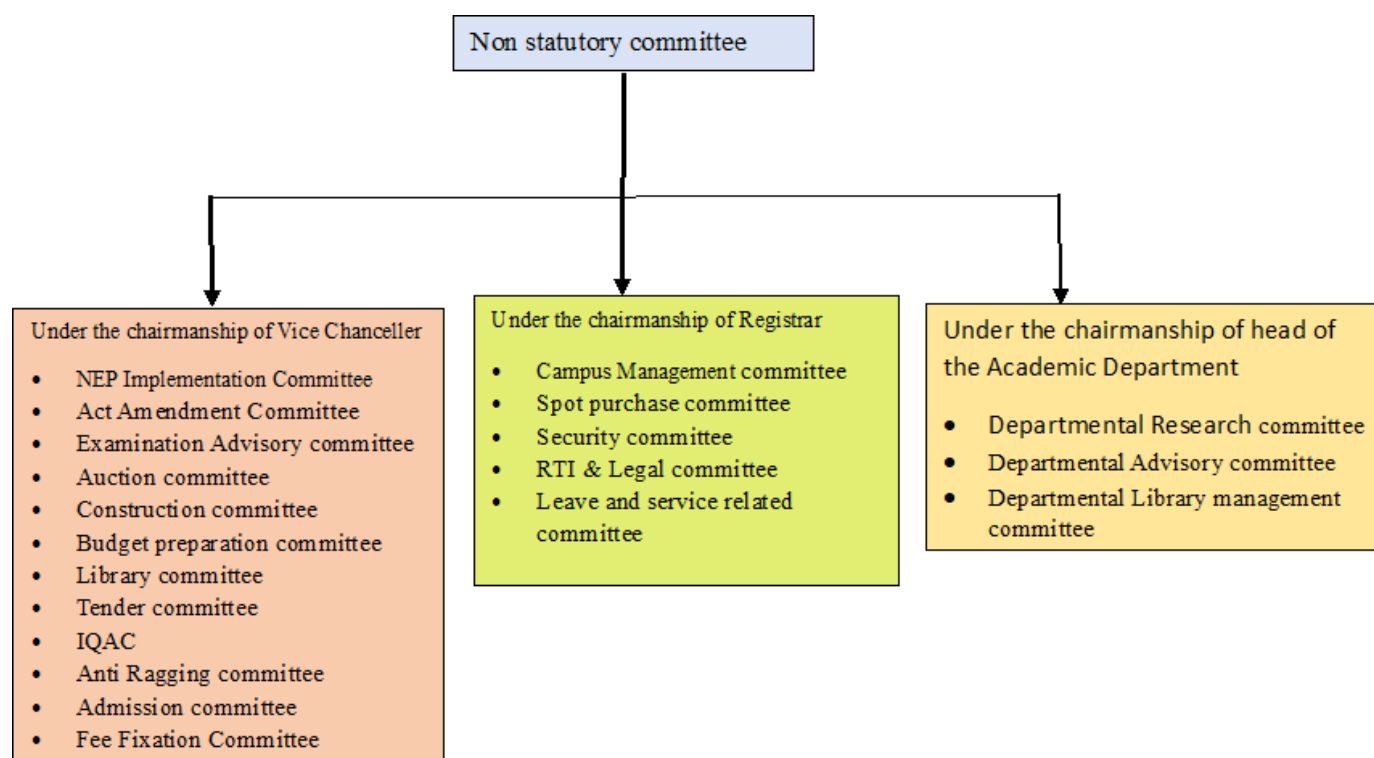
University Organogram - A

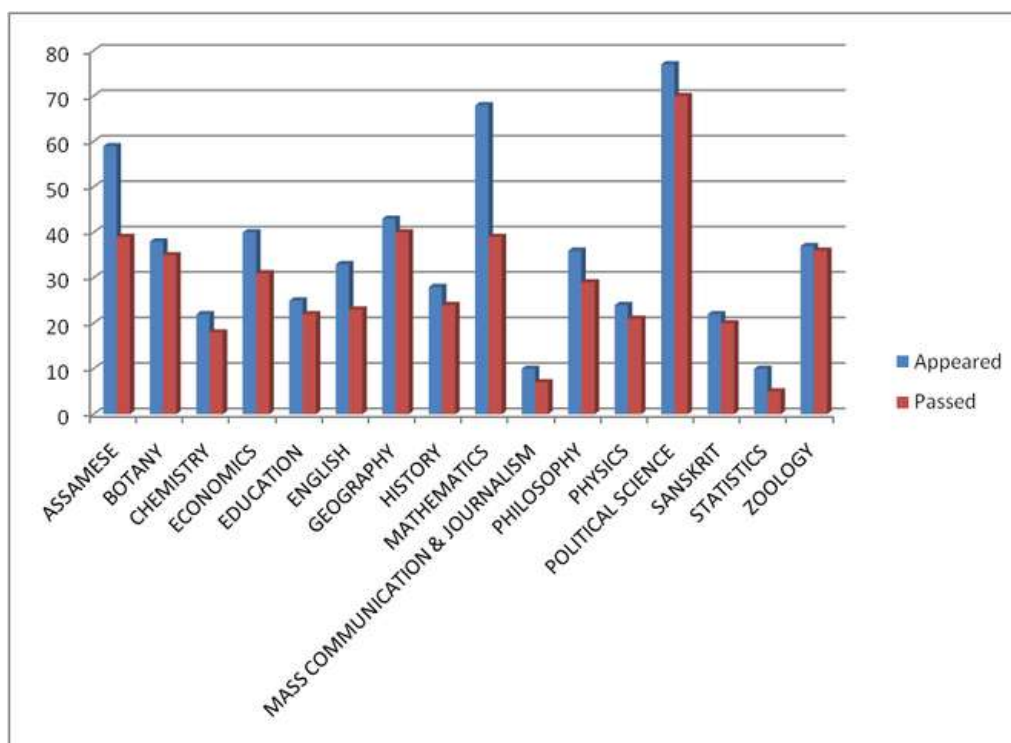

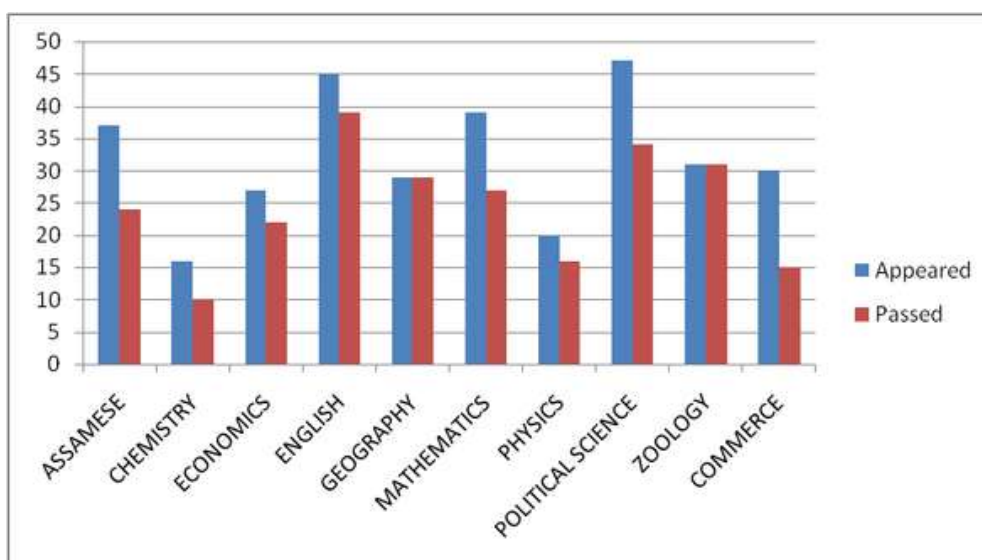

• Library and Information Centre, Bhattadev University

The Library and Information Centre of Bhattadev University was established in the year 1955 while being a part of the erstwhile Bajali College. The library caters to the needs of the students, teachers and research scholars belonging to the different departments of the university. It has been able to serve the basic academic requirements as felt by the student and teaching fraternity of the university by being well-equipped with the necessary number and kind of books, journals, magazines, newspapers and e-resources. The library avails the opportunity to purchase books and other allied facilities to meet the ever growing interest of the students and the research scholars engaged in different fields of academic interest. Students in considerable number visit the library, and the library has a seating capacity for 100 numbers of students to sit at a time. The stock of books in the Library and Information Centre, Bhattadev University has been significantly increased and improved upon of late, and it has a tie-up with INFLIBNET. Library Automation work facility is available here and there is provision of internet facility for both students and teachers. The library is also equipped with photostat facility. It is well furnished with ICT facility like OPAC, Yes, Soul 2.0 library software together with NLIS facility. Students and teachers can have easy access to e-resources and they could also download and print the same. A full time Librarian is in charge of the Library and Information Centre of Bhattadev University. Other than him, the library has a staff strength of 1 (one) Assistant Librarian and 2 (two) Library Bearers. Very soon, 2 (two) vacant posts of Library Assistant and 2 (two) vacant posts of Library Bearer are going to be filled up.

• Bhattadev University Press

Bhattadev University Press was established in the year 2016 and Mr. Apurba Talukdar is the Teacher-in- Charge of the Press. The Press is equipped with a Swift 300 Gold Offset Printing Machine with Double Master facility, perforation and half label cutting machine, stitching machine, etc. All publications and printing works related to Bhattadev University are carried out by the press. Documents and books pertaining to the various departments of the university are published by the press. It also undertakes the task of printing the university prospectus, academic books, journals, writing pads, answer scripts for all examinations conducted by the university, copies for service books of the employees of the university, registers required for different official purposes and other related materials required for university purpose from time to time.

• Institutional Biotech HUB

The Institutional Biotech Hub at Bhattadev University, Bajali, was established in 2014 under the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India.
