FOREWORD

Bhattadev University began its journey on 24th June 2019 as a university. Although a new campus is currently under construction at Medhikuchi, the University is still functioning with the infrastructure inherited from Bajali College, which was upgraded to the state university by an Act of Assam Legislative Assembly. The institution currently offers 18 undergraduate (UG) and 10 postgraduate (PG) programmes in addition to PhD programmes under six of its academic departments. The total student strength stands around 2500 presently. Further, the university is also preparing to affiliate the 18 colleges of Bajali and Barpeta district.

The University has been able to recruit as many as 34 teachers including XX Associate Professors and YY Assistant Professors during 2023-2024 and thus, having recruited some talented individuals in its faculty it is poised to take significant strides in its path to becoming a mature university by conducting its teaching and research programmes effectively.

The present Annual Report for the financial year 2023-2024 has been presently formulated. Since it is yet to be placed before the Court for approval, it is naturally a draft report. However, it has attempted to capture all essential information regarding the university.

This report encompasses all relevant academic and administrative information of this university for the period 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2024. It is hoped that it will give a comprehensive overview of the activities and performance of the University during the period under review.

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A Profile of Bhattadev University, Bajali

Bhattadev University, Bajali, is the realisation of a long cherished dream of the people of greater Bajali region, Assam that came into being on 24th of June, 2019 after the first Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof. Birinchi Kr. Das, assumed office. The University was upgraded from the erstwhile Bajali College which had a glorious history of more than six decades and was widely recognised as one of the prominent educational institutions of the state of Assam. Bajali College was the fruition of the vision and dedication of many prominent individuals of Bajali and the toil and sacrifice of the local agrarian community who contributed from their meager earnings to the establishment of the college. Bajali College grew under the dynamic leadership of late Kameswar Das, a Gold Medalist from Calcutta University. Bajali College from its humble origin in the year 1955 strived towards academic excellence became one of the best colleges for science education in Assam. It is imperative to mention here that Bajali College started Postgraduate programmes in Geography and Zoology way back in the early 1980s, and the Postgraduate programme in the Department of Geography being the second oldest one in Assam after that of Gauhati University. Bajali College endeavoured in its pursuit of academic excellence and was accredited with “A” Grade in its 2nd cycle of NAAC Assessment in the year 2016. The University was established by an Act of the State Legislature - Bhattadev University Act, 2017 to which the Governor of Assam gave his assent on 16 October, 2017. It is named after an illustrious son of Assam, Baikunthanath Bhagavat Bhattacharya popularly known as Bhattadev, who is acknowledged as the father of Assamese prose. Bhattadev’s erudition in Sanskrit grammar and literature, and his command over the *Shrimadbhagavata Purana* earned him the title of Bhagavat Bhattacharya.

The University has inherited four Postgraduate programme in Geography, Zoology, Assamese and Mathematics from the college and started Postgraduate programme in Physics in the very first year of its inception. A five year integrated M.Sc. programme in Chemistry was introduced in the Academic Session 2022-23. Besides the ongoing Postgraduate programmes, The University has introduced Postgraduate programmes in Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, English and Political Science from the Academic Session 2023-24. The University has a plan to commence Undergraduate programmes in Computer Science and Sociology for which two new departments, viz., Department of Computer Science and Engineering, and Department of Sociology have been created in this year and one faculty member per department has been recruited. The University, under the leadership of Prof. Birinchi Kr. Das, has also begun Ph.D. research programmes in several subject areas with effect from 2021.

The Government of Assam has allotted a larger plot of land to build a second campus of the University at a nearby place called Medhikuchi where, with generous funding from the Government of Assam, new construction works have already begun. In addition, the institution is developing and refurbishing its infrastructure at its existing campus at Pathsala town. **As many as 15 Assistant Professors and 8 Associate Professors** have been appointed recently as in various departments of the University. The University is also taking steps to recruit non-teaching staff members against sanctioned posts.

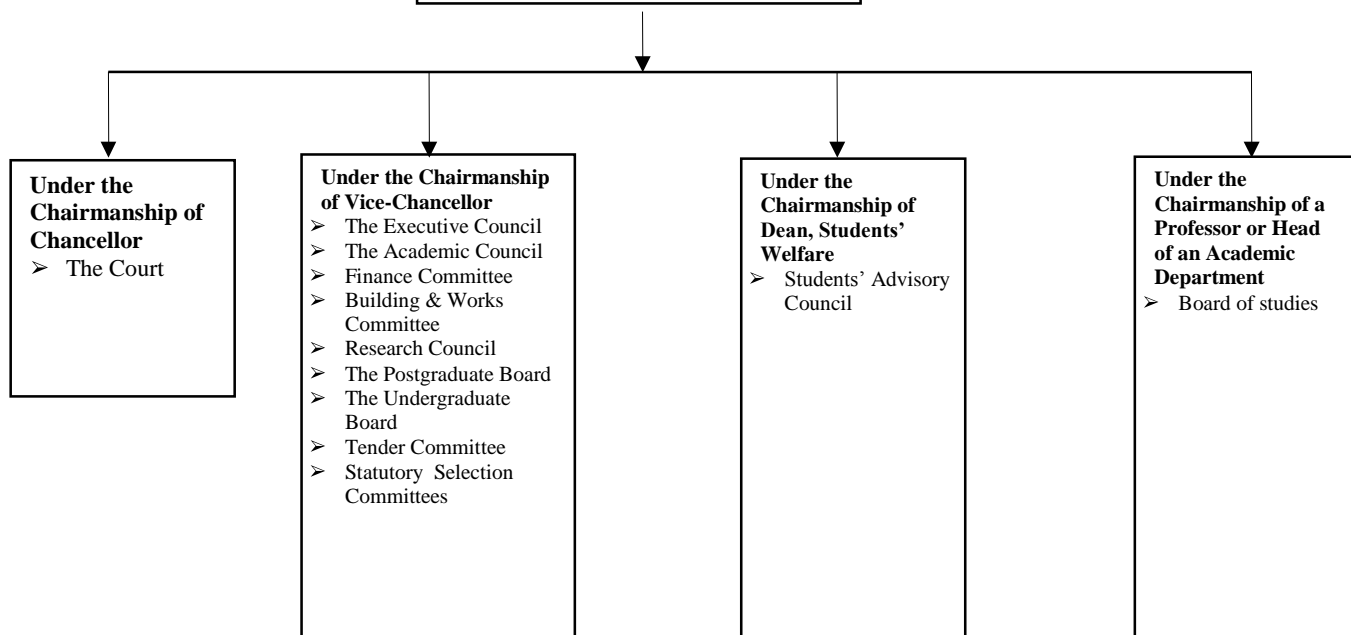
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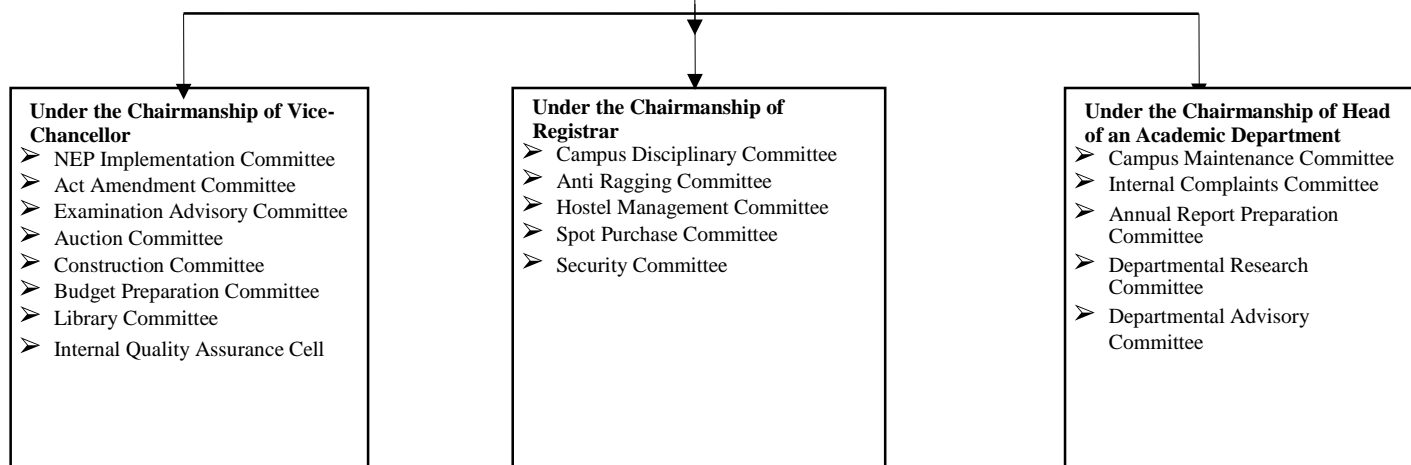

Library Automation work facility is available here and there is provision of internet facility for both students and teachers. The library is also equipped with photostat facility. It is well furnished with ICT facility like OPAC, Yes, Soul 2.0 library software together with NLIS facility. Students and teachers can have easy access to e-resources and they could also download and print the same. A full time Librarian is in charge of the Library and Information Centre of Bhattadev University. Other than him, the library has a staff strength of 1 (one) Assistant Librarian and 2 (two) Library Bearers. Institutional Biotech Hub at Bhattadev University, Bajali was established in the year of 2014 under the aegis of Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India. Incorporation of such an advanced laboratory at University level is to inculcate interest for Biotechnology among the budding scientist at UG, PG and PhD level. Also, it will impart training in sophisticated technology by providing necessary infrastructural facility. Apart from its own research activities the hub has engaged in many, Biological Science related activities.
