PROF. DHANAPATI DEKA TAKES OATH AS THE VICE-CHANCELLOR OF BHATTADEV UNIVERSITY



On July 29, 2024, Shri Gulab Chand Kataria, the Hon'ble Governor of Assam and Chancellor of Bhattadev University, administered the oath of office to Prof. Dhanapati Deka as the Vice-Chancellor for a five-year term. Prof. Deka assumed office on August 7, 2024. A distinguished academician and researcher, he was awarded the Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry (FRSC) in 2023. Currently, Prof. Deka is a Professor on lien in the Department of Energy at Tezpur University, where he has held various leadership roles, including Head of the Department, Dean of Students Welfare, and Dean of Research and

Development. With notable international-recognition, he has made significant research contributions and established collaborations with renowned national and international institutions. Prof. Deka has over 4,300 citations and an h-index of 35. He has also visited several countries, including the USA, Brazil, Sweden, Spain, Finland, and Hungary, as a Visiting Scientist. After taking office, he shared his vision for the University's development, focusing on academic growth, research excellence, and enhanced student support to elevate the institution to global standards.

The Department of Botany, Bhattadev University conducted a one-day hands-on training program on the Management of Water Hyacinth (Eichhornia crassipes) on August 30, 2024. The program aimed to educate participants about sustainable approaches to manage and utilize water hyacinth, a prevalent invasive aquatic weed. The program was inaugurated by the Registrar (i/c) of Bhattadev University, Dr. Subhash Chandra Das, who emphasized the importance of combating invasive species through innovative and sustainable methods in his address. The resource person for the event was Mr. Lakhan Sarkar, Assistant Professor at the College of Horticulture & Farming System Research, Nalbari. His

expertise in sustainable horticultural practices and farming systems enriched the training session, offering valuable insights into the practical applications of water hyacinth management. The session commenced with an overview of the ecological and economic impacts of water hyacinth, followed by demonstrations of effective techniques for its removal, control, and potential uses in composting, bioenergy, and **Participants** handicrafts. engaged hands-on activities, gaining practical experience under the expert guidance of Mr. Sarkar. The event saw enthusiastic participation from 50 individuals, including students, researchers, and faculty members.


NCC UNIT:


