Inauguration of Bhattadev University's new campus at Medhikuchi



Bhattadev University witnessed a significant milestone as the Chief Minister of Assam Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma inaugurated the new campus of the University at Medhikuchi on December 30, 2025, marking a significant milestone in the state's higher education sector. The inauguration ceremony was attended by Education Minister of Assam Dr. Ranoj Pegu, Ranjeet Kumar Dass, Minister of PNRD and MLA, Patacharkuchi LAC, Phani Bhusan Choudhury, MP, Barpeta HPC, Phanidhar Talukdar, MLA, Bhawanipur LAC along with senior officials and local representatives. The ceremony commenced with the welcome address delivered by Prof. Dhanapati Deka, the Vice Chancellor of Bhattadev University. In his speech, Chief Minister, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma highlighted the transformative role of digital technology in shaping Assam's future. He stated that within the next few years, the state would witness rapid technological advancement.

"Through digital platforms, a professor will be able to teach students across every corner of Assam from a single location," the Chief Minister said. Emphasising the scope of telemedicine, Sarma added, "A doctor sitting in America will be able to treat a patient in Assam," underlining the government's vision of integrating technology into education and healthcare. Speaking on the occasion, Education Minister, Dr. Ranoj Pegu highlighted that Bhattadev University is being envisioned as a "Global Smart University", with a strong focus on technology-driven education, research and innovation.

The university campus has been developed under a project worth Rs 52.99 crores and is spread across 120 bighas of land. The new campus comprises of a modern administrative block, three academic buildings equipped with advanced laboratories, residential facilities for the Vice-Chancellor and other officials, and a cafeteria for students and staff. These state-of-the-art amenities are expected to substantially strengthen the University's academic and administrative capabilities. A large gathering was witnessed on the day of the inauguration of the Medhikuchi campus.

Bhattadev University and NIELIT Launch 60-Hour Summer Internship Program on Python and Computational Skills

Bhattadev University, in collaboration with the National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), organized a 60-hour Summer Internship Program from June 25 to July 17, 2025.
