**Bhattadev University organises one-day workshop on Entrepreneurship in Fisheries Sector**

**Pathsala, 19 November:** Bhattadev University, Bajali, organised a one-day training cum awareness program on "Entrepreneurship development in Fisheries Sector" on Tuesday. The program was jointly organised by Bhattadev University, Bajali and National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), North Eastern Regional centre, Guwahati in collaboration with Department of Fisheries, Bajali District, Assam.

In his inaugural speech, Prof. Dhanapati Deka, Vice Chancellor of Bhattadev University emphasized on the need of exploration and adoption of fisheries along with future possibilities for entrepreneurship development. He also stated the social responsibilities of the government agencies and institutions for shaping prosperous economic development model.
