UNIVERSITY PROFILE



Bhattadev University, Bajali, is the realization of a long-cherished dream of the people of the greater Bajali region, Assam, which came into being on the **24th of June, 2019**, after the first Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof. Birinchi Kr. Das, assumed office.

The University was upgraded from the erstwhile Bajali College, which had a glorious history of more than six decades and was widely recognized as one of the prominent educational institutions in the state of Assam. The University was established by an Act of the State Legislature - Bhattadev University Act, 2017, to which the Governor of Assam gave his assent on the **16th of October, 2017**.

It is named after an illustrious son of Assam, Baikunthanath Bhagavat Bhattacharya, popularly known as Bhattadev, who is acknowledged as the father of Assamese prose.



Bhattadev's erudition in Sanskrit grammar and literature, along with his command over the Shrimadbhagavata Purana, earned him the title of Bhagavat Bhattacharya.



Bajali College was the fruition of the vision and dedication of many prominent individuals of Bajali, as well as the toil and sacrifice of the local agrarian community, who contributed from their earnings of selling rice paddy to the establishment of the college.



Bajali College was established under the dynamic leadership of Kameswar Das, a Gold Medalist from Calcutta University.

OUR JOURNEY

FROM A LEGACY OF EXCELLENCE TO A FUTURE OF IMPACT



A LEGACY THAT INSPIRES

Beginning as Bajali College in 1955, the institution steadily grew into one of Assam's leading centres for science education. It introduced postgraduate programmes in Geography and Zoology in the early 1980s, with the M.Sc. in Geography becoming the second oldest programme in Assam after Gauhati University. The college was awarded NAAC "A" Grade in its second cycle in 2016.



EVOLVING INTO A UNIVERSITY

Established as Bhattadev University in 2019, the institution expanded its academic offerings by launching postgraduate programmes in Physics and a 5-year Integrated M.Sc. in Chemistry from the 2022–23 academic session. At present, the University offers 10 Master's programmes across disciplines including Mathematics, Assamese, Zoology, Geography, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, English, Physics, and Political Science, along with Ph.D. programmes introduced from 2021 onward.



BUILDING FOR TOMORROW

To support future growth, the Government of Assam has allotted land for a second campus at Medhikuchi, where new infrastructure development is underway. Simultaneously, the existing campus at Pathsala is being modernized, and NEP 2020 has been implemented from the academic session 2023–24. The University has recently appointed 16 Assistant Professors and is actively recruiting additional teaching and non-teaching staff for newly sanctioned posts.



AN EMBLEM OF KNOWLEDGE

The University emblem, adapted from the emblem of erstwhile Bajali College, carries the Puranic motto "Sā Vidya Yā Vimuktaye" — "Knowledge is that which liberates." Guided by this vision, Bhattadev University aspires to become a centre of excellence that nurtures knowledge, social responsibility, and innovative solutions for society.

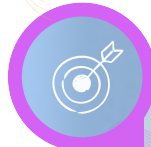
Our VISION and MISSION

Admission Process for FYUGP & FYIMP

All applications must be submitted through the official **SAMARTH online admission portal** of the Department of Higher Education, Government of Assam: <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>.

Applicants are strongly encouraged to generate their **Unique ID** from the Higher Education Department and complete the registration, profile filling, and program selection processes well before the deadlines. All activities, including merit list generation and admission, are governed by timelines released by the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam.

Merit List Criteria

Admissions are purely merit-based and follow standard norms:

- AHSEC Students: Merit list will consider English and Assamese/Alt. English (compulsory) + Best three elective subjects.
- CBSE/Other Boards: Best five subjects from respective streams will be considered.

INSTITUTIONAL BIOTECH HUB

Institutional Biotech Hub at Bhattadev University, Bajali was established in the year of 2014 under the aegis of Department of Biotechnology, Govt of India. Incorporation of such an advanced laboratory at University level (formerly Bajali College) is to inculcate interest for Biotechnology among the budding scientist at UG, PG and PhD level. Also, it will impart training in sophisticated technology by providing necessary infrastructural facility. Apart from its own research activities the hub has engaged in many, Biological Science related activities. Starting from its inception every year workshops, seminars, awareness & training programs are being conducted at our own institution and nearby schools and college level.

Financial assistance received from DBT

- 1 Initial Funding Boost (2013–14):** Received ₹26.50 lakhs in the first year, marking the major initial investment phase.
- 2 Subsequent Allocations:** Funding tapered to ₹4.02 lakhs in 2014–15 and ₹3.44 lakhs in 2015–16, indicating a decline in annual support.

- **Twister:** Used for enhancing core strength and flexibility.
- **Abdominal Raised Bench:** For abdominal workouts and core strengthening exercises.
- **Lat Pulley:** A machine for exercises targeting the back and shoulders.
- **Dumbbells:** A wide range of dumbbells for various strength training exercises.
- **Weight Lifting Sets:** Complete sets for full-body weight lifting exercises.
- **Weight Training Bar:** Used for barbell exercises, focusing on strength building.



INITIAL USE CASE

Bhattadev University aimed to ensure that both regular and sport-specialized students had access to diverse facilities for fitness, training, and competition.

SOLUTION

The university invested in building outdoor playgrounds, a cemented basketball court, indoor table tennis space, and a modern gymnasium equipped with weight-training gear.

NEXT PHASE

Planned expansion of sporting events, inter-college tournaments, and additional coaching support to uplift the campus sports ecosystem.

FINAL PHASE

Sustain and scale the facilities while introducing performance tracking, health monitoring, and more student-led recreational sports initiatives.
